

## **Administrator/Finance Director Report 8/10/2022**

### ARPA Funds

1. Second tranche arrived June 21 (\$161,817.59)

### Elections

1. 678 people voted in the Partisan Primary 205 via absentee ballot
2. Five Absentee ballots were rejected because the certification was incomplete (either missing witness address or voter signature). Contact was attempted with voter but was not resolved by 8 p.m. on Election Day.
3. Three absentee ballots were received in the mail the day after the election

### Human Resources

1. On July 13<sup>th</sup> Jennifer and I attended a CVMIC webinar regarding staff retention
2. CVMIC will conduct Anti-harassment training for all staff on August 15
3. Due to staff availability, the M-F hours for the pool adjusted to 11:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. starting August 13 through the end of the season (August 28). No changes to Saturday and Sunday hours are expected at this time.

3. In July \$82.11 in revenue from the EV charger was collected by the City. The electrical expense for the service was \$25.02. Net +\$2.91 for the month. Net revenue to date \$(19.02). It has been reported that a City resident was the primary user of the charger. She is in the process of having a charger installed at her residence.
