

RESOLUTION 19-04

AUTHORIZING A PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the current storm sewer system located near the Dollar General (717 N. Main St.) is not adequate to mitigate flooding in the area due to increased rainfall; and,

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Lodi (City) approved \$75,000 in the 2019 budget in the Tax Incremental Financing (TIF) District #3 Fund for storm sewer (waterway) improvements in this area; and,

WHEREAS, the City previously incurred roughly \$9,000 in expenses studying the storm sewer modifications in this area in 2017; and,

WHEREAS, the City previously received more expensive quotes to use outside contractors to complete the work; and,

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee and the Director of Operations feel this storm sewer modification can be addressed using City employees at the much lower, 2019 budgeted amount; and,

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee recommends moving forward with this storm sewer project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Common Council of the City of Lodi, Wisconsin approves moving forward with the project consisting of modifications to the storm sewer system located near the Dollar General (717 N. Main St.).
