

**RESOLUTION 19-13**

**AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR INSPECTION AGENCY REGISTRATION  
WITH THE STATE OF WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY AND  
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the state now requires all municipalities that wish to exercise jurisdiction over electrical wiring of commercial real estate have to register as an electrical inspection agency per SPS 316.011(1)(a) and meet other conditions in SPS 316.011(1)(a)2-6; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lodi does choose to exercise jurisdiction over electrical wiring of commercial real estate; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lodi contracts with a certified commercial electrical inspector to perform electrical inspection activities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Lodi will forward the required application identifying the City of Lodi and the City representative, along with required additional documents and fee of \$55.00 for a four-year term, to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services by the March 1, 2019, deadline.
