

RESOLUTION 21-71
ESTABLISHING A NEW WARD MAP

WHEREAS, it is necessary for every city, village and town in Columbia County, Wisconsin to identify wards as part of the 2021 redistricting process, and

WHEREAS, wards are required to be established in accordance with Section 5.15 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Lodi Common Council does hereby create five (5) ward(s), as follows:

Ward One – which shall be a portion of Supervisory District # 26

Ward Two – which shall be a portion of Supervisory District # 26

Ward Three – which shall be a portion of Supervisory District # 27

Ward Four – which shall be a portion of Supervisory District # 27

Ward Five – which shall be a portion of Supervisory District # 27

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above ward boundaries are outlined and identified on the attached map (Attachment A), which is incorporated and made a part hereof, and that the map is generated using WISE-LR software in order to incorporate the underlying census block numbers within each ward.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for all voting purposes, the above ward(s) will be combined to facilitate the use of one common polling place, which will be Lodi City Hall, 130 S Main St, Lodi WI 53555.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the municipal clerk send a copy of the adopted resolution and ward plan to the County Clerk within 5 days after adoption.
